CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe B. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from 5-Mile Spring through pipe line, 3 troughs and 2 earth reservoirs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 1 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 10, bears S. 35° 55' 20" E., a distance of 1,071.64 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: E.W. Fallini Estate and J.B. Fallini
Post-office address: Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0163 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 cattle and 20 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 24, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed at the spring area, thence conveyed northeasterly by 14,147 feet of pipe line to three watering troughs and two earth reservoirs where it is used for stock watering purposes. The place of use is described as being in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 7, T. 1 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
