CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Salvador Urrutia has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring # 4 through ditches and reservoir for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 20 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 18 bears N. 46° 18' 13" E., 2,705.53 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Salvador Urrutia
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0155 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle and 2,000 sheep
Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 10, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a developed spring area by ditches to a reservoir located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water stock and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
