CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, pump and ditches irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 44 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 47° 13' E., 1,956.0 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 3.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed 960 ac-ft. per season

Period of use, from: March 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 12, 1957

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table listing land parcels with columns for acreage and section details. Includes entries for 9.79, 37.83, 39.22, 37.48, 36.99, 38.86, 39.83 acres and a total of 240.00 acres.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
