

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Cecil Martin has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 35 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 24 bears S. 56° 04' 47" W., 1,815.17 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation: 1.5 c.f.s. but not to exceed 153.88 ac-ft. annually

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 3, 1958

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 4 columns: Area, Section, Township, Range. Rows include 1.38 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 24, T. 35 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M.; 15.42 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4; 19.90 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4; 1.77 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4; 38.47 Total Acres.

* The total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
