CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mule Spring through pipe line and troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 28, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 31° 05' W., 11,110.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Vera Krupp
Post-office address Blue Diamond, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle
Period of use, from May 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 28, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a spring and runs into a 10,000 gallon holding basin thence westerly through 6,500 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to a watering trough where it is used for stock watering purposes. The place of use is located within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 17, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
