CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 41 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 4 bears N. 47° 21' E. a distance of 93.75 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.
