

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS: John R. Ervin, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring No. 1 through tank, pipe line and distribution system for recreational and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 8 bears S. 10° 42' E., a distance of 1,070.30 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Washoe County Council of Camp Fire Girls

Post-office address: Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.5 c.f.g.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 8, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed from a spring and is conveyed by a pipe line into a sediment tank, thence northeasterly by 1200 feet of 2 inch pipe line into a 3,000 gallon steel reservoir, thence to wash stand and showers, located in the W 1/2 Section 9, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for recreational and domestic purposes.

\* This certificate changes the manner of use under Permit 12157, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit 12157.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
