

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Joe Eldridge has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eldridge Spring through dams and ponds for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE¹ SE¹ Sec. 35, T. 14 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 34° 14' 30" E., a distance of 2.165 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s. or sufficient to water
Period of use, from January 1st to 200 head of cattle
December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 31, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded by a series of small, earth-filled dams, six feet high, making three ponds approximately 125 feet in diameter; ponds located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used for stock watering purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
