CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS R. S. Leighton has presented to the State Engineer Director Land & Water Rights of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 8) through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 12 bears S. 85° 19' E. a distance of 4,623.0 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 7, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a distribution system where it serves a portion of the City of Reno, within Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13 and 14, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., This water is used to supplement water diverted to the system from the Truckee River.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
