CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. A. Eula and Bill Eller has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 12 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 6 bears N. 19° 14' 30" W., a distance of 4,733.0 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 3.1 c.f.s. but not to exceed 648 ac-ft. per season.
Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 18, 1960

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 6 columns: Acres, Section, Township, Range, Meridian, Total Acres. Rows include 38.0 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 6, T. 12 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B. & M., and 162.0 Total Acres.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
