CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James R. Kilduff has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fairfield Spring No. 1 through spring, dam, pipe line and sprinklers for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 19, bears N. 20° 07' W. a distance of 746.80 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* This certificate changes the place of use of permit 17553, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as permit 17553.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
