CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Miriam I. Taylor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Troy Creek through earthen dam and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 6 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Sec. 23, T. 6 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M. bears N. 55° 10' W. 12.765 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.8 c.f.s. but not to exceed 97.188 ac-ft. per season
Period of use, from: May 1st to September 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 17, 1954

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 24.297 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 6 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
