

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Joe Eldridge has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eldridge Spring No. 2 through dam for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 14 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 35, bears S. 58° 56' E., a distance of 3,010.0 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from April 1st to October 15th of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation August 31, 1961

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
1.028 acres in the S 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 14 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
