CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clarence W. Jackson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from spring through spring, box, pipe line and watering troughs for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 43 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 36 bears N. 53° 46' W. a distance of 6,106 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Rebel Creek Ranch, Inc.
Post-office address Orovada, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0373 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle and 2,500 sheep
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 26, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a box at the spring site and piped approximately one (1) mile northwesterly to watering troughs located within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 26 and the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 43 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water 800 head of cattle, 2,500 sheep and for domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
