CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E. G. Cornell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

"A" Spring
through spring and ditches for
irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 13 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 29 bears S. 39° 10' E., a distance of 3,357.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.42 c.f.s. but not to exceed 248.8 ac-ft. per season.

Period of use, from May 1st to October 31st of each year

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
