

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. Dean Kastins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pressure system for recreational (park water supply) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 13 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 7° 03' 30" E., a distance of 2,732.00 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.038 c.f.g.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 22, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped into a pressure system from where it is used for park supply and watering lawns located within portions of S 1/4 S 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, T. 13 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
