CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank G. Arcularius has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (South Well) through drilled well, pump, storage tank and troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4, NE 1/4, Sec. 19, T. 1 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.E. corner of Sec. 32, T. 1 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 24°40' E. 15,247.0 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Frank G. Howard and F.H. Arcularius

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from October 15th to May 1st of each year the following

Date of priority of appropriation August 8, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pumped into a 45,000 gallon storage tank from whence it is conveyed by pipe to watering troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
