CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Rene W. Lemaire has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Lemaire Well No. 1) through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 32 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 18 bears S. 60° E. a distance of 1.491 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 593.025, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* This certificate changes the place of use of permit 13603, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as permit 13603.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
