CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 35 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 25 bears N. 40° 41' 50" E., a distance of 165.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 233.423, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 3.50 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1,261.52 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from: March 1st to November 15th of each year
