CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 21) through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 23 bears N. 86° 55' 30" W. a distance of 1,331.07 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 3.5 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1,238.8 acre-feet per season

Period of use, from May 1st to November 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 5, 1955

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
