

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Preston W. Allen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, tank and pipe lines for Commercial (sawmill) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 11 bears N. 73° 12' E., a distance of 2,637.0 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0186 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 9, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well, pumped into a 300 gallon tank at well site; thence conveyed to the sawmill by pipe line where it is used for cooling 2 saws and feed works and general domestic purposes. The place of use is located within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2 and the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
