CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kermit M. Paulson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pump, storage tank and pipeline for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2 (SE 1/4) Sec. 27 T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which center corner of said Sec. 27 bears S. 31° 22' 07" E., 1,046.50 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from May 1st to October 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 3, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of a private water supply system which includes a supply pipe line from the lake to the pump and then to a storage tank. The water is then distributed to one private dwelling located in Lot 1, Subdivision No. 1 Cave Rock Cove, Ltd. Tract, Douglas County, Nevada.

* This certificate is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
