

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. A. Yelland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mud Springs No. 1, 2, and 3 through developed spring, ditches and reservoirs for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 16 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M.: Spring #1 at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears S. 85° 40' E., a distance of 4,350 feet; Spring #2 at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears S. 76° 40' E., a distance of 4,280 feet; Spring #3 at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears S. 77° 04' E., a distance of 4,330 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72 Chapter 140 Statutes of Nevada, has determined the date of 1916

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0078 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 13, 1916

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from Spring #1 by a ditch and conveyed to a small earthen excavated pond, westerly and adjacent to the spring; water is diverted from Springs #2 and 3 by a ditch and conveyed to a small earthen excavated pond located between the springs. The ponds are used to water 300 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
