CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Orville S. Smiley has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, windmill, storage tank and troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 37 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which N.E. corner of said Sec. 22 bears N. 79° 27' E., a distance of 4,100.00 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Orville S. Smiley

Post-office address Wells, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0051 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use, from March 20th to November 20th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 26, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by a drilled well, pumped by a windmill into a 6,000 gallon buried concrete storage tank, near the windmill; thence 1,560 feet westerly by 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to a 5 feet diameter, 2 feet deep metal tank located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21 T. 37 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.; and from storage tank 450 feet northerly by a 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to a 5 feet diameter by 2 feet deep metal tank located within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T. 37 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M. 300 range cattle are watered at the two tanks.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
