

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Orville S. Smiley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, windmill, storage tank and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 37 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 13 bears S. 88° E., a distance of 506.00 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Post-office address Wells, Nevada
 Amount of appropriation 0.0068 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
 Period of use, from March 15th to December 1st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation September 26, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a drilled well, pumped by a windmill into a 4,000 gallon buried concrete storage tank, thence by pipe to a 400 gallon watering tank located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 400 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
