CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well #5) through well pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 40 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Section 14 T. 40 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 65° 51' E., a distance of 9,279.00 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 1.63 c.f.s. but not to exceed 480 ac-ft. annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Rows include 11.6 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T. 40 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M., and a total of 120.0 acres.

* The total duty of water for land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
