CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul T. Quick, Regional Director, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sawmill Spring through pipe line and tanks for wildlife and stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 14 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the N.W. corner of T. 16 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 57° 37' 30" E., 69,350.31 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U. S. Department of the Interior Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife

Post-office address: Portland, Oregon

Amount of appropriation: 0.000167 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 50 deer and mountain sheep

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 1, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from the cleaned out, protective covered spring by means of a 1" plastic pipe line and conveyed to 2 830 gallon underground tanks thence to a 430 gallon open tank and a 12'X 12' drinking basin with a float valve where it is used for the watering of deer and mountain sheep. All works are located within 200 feet of the spring and are within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
