CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Warren R. Clark has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well no. 1) through drilled well, pump, pipelines, sprinkler and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 19 bears N. 74° 58' 44" E., a distance of 1,505.23 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit No. 20306, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 20306.

\*\* The total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
