CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, State Water Right Surveyor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 44 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 Cor. of said Sec. 17 bears N. 34° 38' W., a distance of 205.5 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date,
