CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Merle N. Long, Secretary-Treasurer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pipeline for gold placer mining

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 35 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of Sec. 24, T. 35 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 69° 03' 30" E., a distance of 47,950.0 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Oro Mines, Inc.
Post-office address: Westminster, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.891 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 24, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped northerly approximately 100 yards into a small reservoir; thence pumped to a 4 by 15 foot trommel, thence to 4 centrifugal bowls 5 feet in diameter at the plant. Water after leaving the plant is returned to the reservoir, after being cleaned by passing through trailing gravel piles and a settling pond, for reuse. The place of use is located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
