

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Rilla Custer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Custer Spring No. 1 through developed spring area, storage tank and pipeline for commercial and domestic (residence and duplex) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 23, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 23 bears N. 85° 40' 56" E., 2,189.21 feet. situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed at the spring site and enclosed in a concrete block collection box thence conveyed to a sand trap and then by means of a pipeline is conveyed to a 10,000 gallon storage tank serving 1 duplex and 1 residence located in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
