CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Don H. Tibbals, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, tank and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 61° 21' 24" W., a distance of 1,850.48 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 10, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a drilled well, thence pumped northeasterly approximately 2,900 feet through a pipe to a 130,000 gallon galvanized steel storage tank, within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B. & M., from which water is distributed by four, 6 and 8 inch mains, supplying the place of use within portions of E 1/2 NW 1/4 W 1/2 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
