CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. SETTELMAYER - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 1) through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 31 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 11° 50' W., 1,610.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Rose and Colburn, copartnership of William B. Rose and Harvey John Rose
Post-office address: Beowawe, Nevada

\* Amount of appropriation: 2.629 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1,037.40 ac-ft. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: February 9, 1960

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 10 columns: Area, and 9 columns for section corners (NE 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4, SW 1/4, etc.). Rows list specific acreage and corner locations, ending with a total of 345.80 acres.

\* The total duty of water for the lands under this certificate shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
