CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Point Spring No. 2 through spring, collection box, pipe and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 10 bears N. 71° 26' E. a distance of 1,568.20 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Vera Krupp
Post-office address: Blue Diamond, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.004 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 20, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from spring, collected in box and piped 50 feet through 1/2 inch pipe to a watering trough, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 150 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
