CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James C. Perkins, Jr. - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed creek (Folwick) through pipeline and dug earth tank for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 3 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 8 bears N. 75° 21' E., a distance of 5,345.0 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Conley Dairy Farms (Partnership of Walter Conley, Lorraine Conley, Anna Conley, and Ruby C. Whaley)
Post-office address Fish Lake Valley via Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 or sufficient to water 200 cattle following

Period of use, from October 10 to June 15 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 30, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
From main source, water is piped to an earthen stock pond 30 feet in diameter, located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 200 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
