CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Martin T. Magnuson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sugar Loaf Springs through spring, pipeline and troughs for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 21 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. Corner of Sec. 27, T. 21 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 76° 14' W., a distance of 8,103.0 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Martin Magnuson Ranch

Post-office address: McGill, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: .00187 or sufficient to water 50 cattle and 10 horses.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 10, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed at the springs and piped in a westerly direction 10,800 feet to two troughs located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T. 21 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used for stock watering purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
