CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Paul T. Quick - Regional Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mormon Wells (Spring) through developed spring and small pond for wildlife and stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 15 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of T. 16 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 55° 38' 50" E., a distance of 42.600.08 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water from two seep areas is diverted to a collecting box located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 15 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., (unsurveyed) for watering 25 deer and mountain sheep and 10 horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
