CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard G. Campbell, Vice President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 4) through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 14 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. Cor. of said Sec. 25 bears N. 53° 13' E., a distance of 3,245.0 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.

Post-office address: Reno, Nevada

\* Amount of appropriation: 544 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,182.72 ac-ft. per season.

Period of use, from: March 15th to: October 10th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 14, 1960

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant, and various acreage and section details. Includes rows for Section 13, Section 24, and Section 25.

\* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
