


# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles C. Armuth, Jr. - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from \_\_\_\_\_ an underground source (SW#8) through drilled well, pump and tank \_\_\_\_\_ for stock watering \_\_\_\_\_ purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4, SE 1/4, Sec. 35, T. 44 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 49° 29' E., a distance of 1,160.0 feet. \_\_\_\_\_ situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bengoa Ranching Co., Inc.  
 Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada  
 Amount of appropriation 0.0155 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 cattle.  
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation May 9, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: \_\_\_\_\_  
Water is diverted from a drilled well, thence pumped by a windmill into a steel tank 20 feet in diameter by 2 1/2 feet deep, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 500 cattle.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
