

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr.-Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (S.W. #2) through drilled well, pump and tanks for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 16, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 73° 30' 53" W., a distance of 4,417.56 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bengoa Ranching Co., Inc.
Post-office address: Orovada, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0618 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2,000 cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 9, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a drilled well, thence pumped into two steel tanks 24 feet long, 3 feet wide and 2 feet deep, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 2,000 cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
