CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bennett James Vasey, State Water Right Surveyor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and sprinkler system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 4 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of said Sec. 34 bears N. 14° 40' W., a distance of 1,295.0 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
