CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest E. Muller, Engineer and Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, pipeline and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 3 bears S. 66° 57' W., a distance of 1,901.80 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water is limited to supplemental irrigation of existing lands as will be determined by the Franktown Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
