CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce DuBose - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and sprinkler system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 11 bears N. 46° 00' W., a distance of 1,883.89 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 2, 1960

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 8 rows of land descriptions: 40.00 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M., followed by seven rows of quarter-section descriptions (NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4) and a total of 320.00 Acres.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the lands under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
