CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS P. M. Gardiner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dike Spring (Trail Creek) through Spring, Collection Box, Pipeline and Reservoir for Mining and Milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 1S., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE Corner of Sec. 1, T. 1S., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. bears N. 56° 48' E., or a distance of 14,380 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.370 c.f.s. not to exceed 87.3 million gallons annually.
Period of use, from January to December of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 13, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected from the spring in a cistern, then conveyed by pipeline to a collection box where it is commingled with water from Trail Canyon Creek and then conveyed by pipeline to the Mill site located in the NE 1/4 of Section 1, T. 1S., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used in processing 500 tons per day of Mercury Ore.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
