CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leslie J. Stewart, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Martin Creek through dam, headgate, ditch & parshall flume for Irrigation, stockwater & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 42N., R. 40E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E 1/2 Corner of said Sec. 22 bears S. 42° 50' E., 2,046.2 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Proof No. 0684, Little Humboldt River Decree, Case No. 3157 hence the dates of priority and period of use as decreed and this certificate is issued subject to the terms and conditions of said Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
