CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pipeline for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 19N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the Ct corner of said Sec. 4, bears N. 68° 20' 29" W., a distance of 58.22 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*Amount of appropriation 0.6684 c.f.s. but not to exceed 153.0 acre feet annually.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 1, 1963

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
34.0 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 4, T. 19N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M.
34.0 acres total

* The total duty of water for the land under this Certificate shall not exceed 4.5 acre feet annually from all sources.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
