CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Jackie M. Tyree has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mitchell Spring through spring and pond for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 8N., R. 27E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 25, bears S. 79° 39' E., a distance of 2,194.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from December 1st to May 31st of each year following
Date of priority of appropriation August 21, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from Mitchell Spring and collected in a small excavated pond at the spring site where it is used to water 100 head of cattle, within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, T. 8N., R. 27E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
