CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Richard McKay has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Snowball Spring No. 10 through pipeline, troughs and reservoir for Stock Watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 12N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 1, T. 12N., R. 52E., M.D.B. & M. bears N. 87° 26' 22" W., 6,148.82 ft. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Richard W. McKay
Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle & 10 horses.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 14, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the spring by means of a head wall & perforated pipe and conveyed by 9,000 ft. of pipeline to 2 troughs and a small earthen reservoir where it is used for the watering of cattle and horses within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
