CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Kenneth H. Glantz has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pipeline, pump & distribution system for Quasi-Municipal & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot III, Sec. 19, T. 16N., R. 18E., M.D.B. & M. (extended) or at a point from which the St corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 24° 50' 15" W., a distance of 2,251.7 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Horizons, Inc.
Post-office address: Stockton, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.42 c.f.s., but not to exceed 9.13 mg. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
*Date of priority of appropriation: September 4, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use:
Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of a pipeline and pump and is conveyed by a distribution system to the place of use located within Section 19, T. 16N., R. 18E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used for the service of 50 homes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit No. 18314 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit No. 18314.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
