

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles C. Armuth, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, windmill & pipeline for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 43N., R. 34E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW Corner of Sec. 31, T. 43N., R. 35E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 89° 01' E., a distance of 18,524 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation .0155 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 9, 1962

Description of works of diversion manner & place of use.
Water is developed by a drilled well and pump by a windmill through a pipeline to a trough 16 feet long by 4 feet wide and 2 feet deep located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
